## *Cambiata Choral Concepts*

The works listed below are musically (range, rhythmic difficulty, and pitch difficulty) accessible to an intermediate-advanced SA[C]TB choir. Consideration include range, rhythm and pitch difficulty. Over the years, every work was performed by one of my middle school (grades 7-8) mixed choirs. For the teacher and students to succeed, music reading skills are required.
